AL PARDA, *Kentucky, New Britain. Light but fast and scrappy. Alert fumble-hawk, deadly tackler and ace in secondary defense. Won place at center on several All-South teams at Kentucky.*

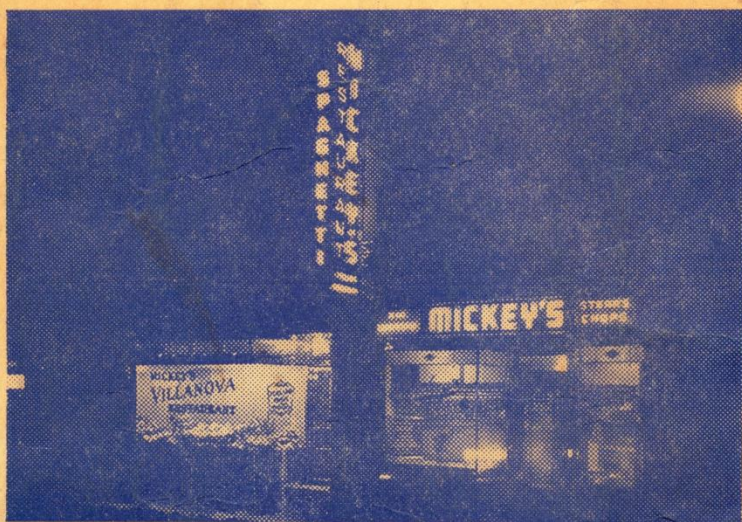
