## FOLLOW THE GAME

### Procedure and Teams

#### Length of Game

The game is sixty minutes long, divided into four quarters of fifteen minutes each. There is an intermission of one minute between the first and second quarters and the third and fourth quarters. Between the second and third quarters (first and second halves) there is an intermission of ten minutes.

#### Choice of Goals

The choice of the goal and kick-off is determined before the start of the game by tossing up a coin. The winner of the toss has the choice of goal or kick-off, while the loser has the alternate choice.

#### Kick-Off

The opening play of the first and third quarters is the kick-off. The kick-off consists of the ball being kicked from some point on the forty-yard line or behind it. The kicking team with the exception of the man holding the ball must be behind this line when the ball is kicked.

All the opponents must be on the other side of the fifty-yard line until the ball is kicked, and at least five players must remain within five yards of the line until then.

#### Necessary Gains on Downs

The team in possession of the ball has four consecutive downs to advance the ball ten yards. If this is not done the ball goes to the opponents on the fifth down.

#### Position of the Players

In a scrimmage the team in possession of the ball must have seven or more players on the line of scrimmage when the ball is snapped.

The backfield players, except the man who first receives the ball from the center, must be at least one yard back of the line of scrimmage when the ball is snapped.

## PENALTIES

### Loss of Ball

No.

1. Failure to advance ball ten yards in four downs.
2. Forward pass touched by ineligible player.
3. Second kick out of bounds at kick-off.

### Loss of Fifteen Yards

4. Substitute communicating before ball is put in play
5. Failure to come to stop in shift play.
6. Intentionally grounding pass to save loss of yardage.
7. Interference by passing team with player eligible for catch. (Also loss of down).
8. Interference with opportunity to make fair catch.
9. Throwing to ground the player who has made fair catch
10. Illegal use of hands and arms by players of offensive team.
11. Roughing the kicker.
12. Piling up.
13. Clipping.
14. Tripping, tackling runner out of bounds, etc.
15. More than one representative on the field in case of accident.

### Loss of Five Yards

16. Off side.
17. Request for time-out more than three times during a half.
18. Illegal delay of game by either team.
19. Failure of substitute to report.
20. Player in motion less than five yards back.
21. Ball not put in play by scrimmage when so specified.
