"RED" GRANGE

Justly noted as the phantom of the football field, "Red" Grange makes his first appearance before San Francisco football fans as captain of the Chicago Bears. As a student at the University of Illinois he was captain during his senior year and was three times chosen All-American back (1923, 1924, 1925).

A wizard at long flashy runs, a master of kicking and passing, there is not a department of the game in which he does not excel. It is this mastery of the game which makes him today and will keep him a memorable figure in football history.

"BUCK" BAILEY

The captain of the San Francisco Tiger eleven, regarded as the best lineman on the Pacific Coast for the past two seasons, was the main pillar of offensive and defensive strength of the Olympic Club squad in their games against the leading colleges. "Buck" was captain of the Winged O aggregation last season and piloted the team through the year without a defeat. His greatest achievement was the victory over the University of California team, who tasted their first loss in five years.
