"Knuckles" attended Harrisburg Tech High, starred in football and upon graduation entered N. Y. Military Academy. He then enrolled at Albright College, starring with Albright, he left school during his senior year to enter the pro ranks with the Shenandoah Club. In less than a year's time he was signed by the N. Y. Giants, where he earned the nickname of "Knuckles" because of his hardness.

In addition to New York and Shenandoah, Boyle also played with the Reading "Keys" when that club won the Inter-State title. Boyle is a husky six footer who tips the beams at 235 lbs. He will be used at the guard position and will also see action at the fullback position. Second year with Panthers.

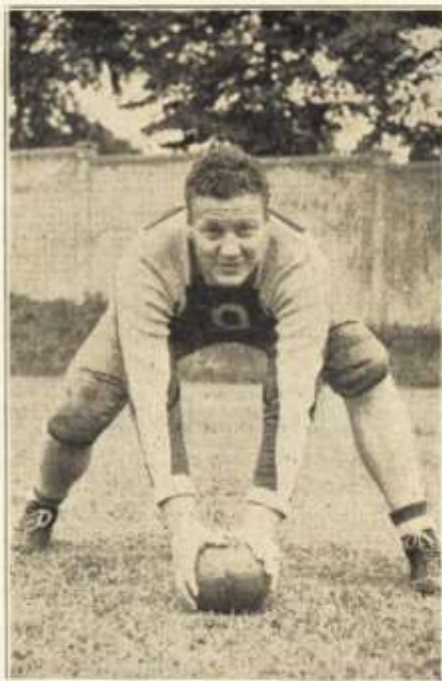

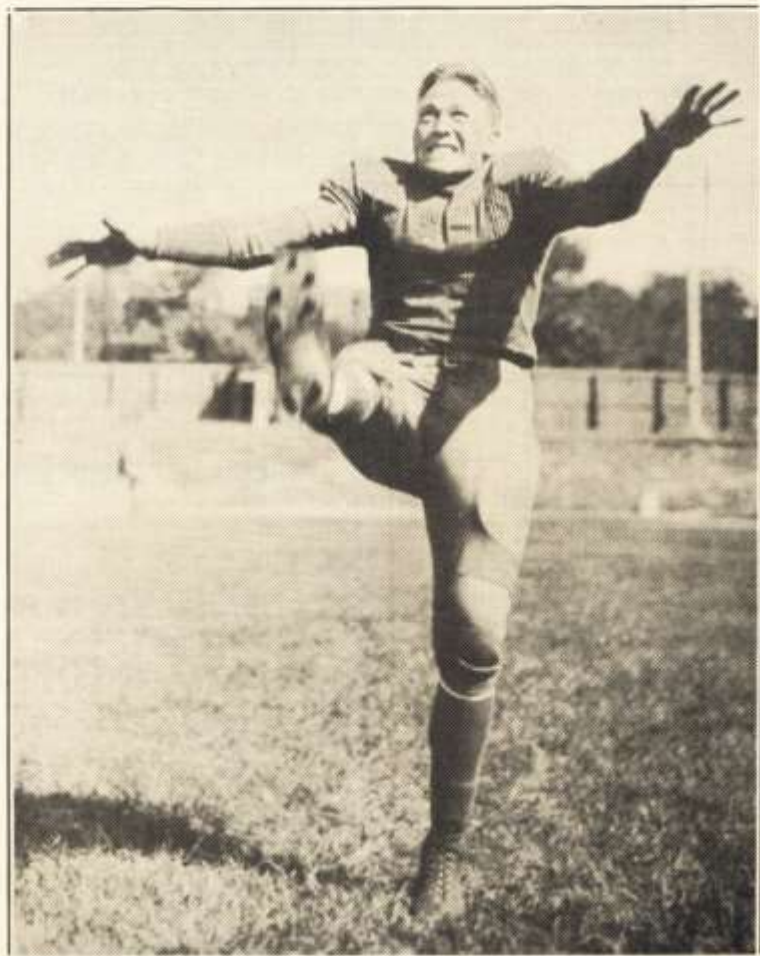
