Through the untiring efforts of one of Bristol's better known citizens goes the credit of placing the West End football team well near the top in New England professional ranks. He is Rebelle E. Carpenter, who for the first time in many seasons has stepped down from active guidance of the Bristol gridiron forces.

It required years for Carpenter to build up the football foundation that now exists. It was a gradual process, one which saw the team rise from the field of average semi-pro players to one of the standout elevens east of the Hudson.

Lack of time for devotion to football caused Carpenter to relinquish the position as manager of this year's team prior to the start of the pre-game activities.

Rebelle or "Ree", as he is frequently called, is president of the West End Athletic club which was formed in 1908 by his late father, Jack Carpenter. Rebelle has been head of the organization for more than a year. He is a member of the Bristol city council and will be seeking his third term in the October city election. He is also a police commissioner and affiliated with several fraternal organizations.

In his younger days Carpenter was an athlete of renown. He played football, basketball and baseball and hailed from a family whose name prominently appeared in state athletic circles over a span of many years.
