

Ernie Nevers is one of the most remarkable athletes in the history of American sport. Glenn Warner, famous coach, names Nevers as the greatest of all football stars, greater than even the Thorpes, Granges, Brickleys and Coys.

Playing for Leland Stanford, Nevers easily won All-American honors for his sensational rushing, kicking and passing.
