R U L E C H A N G E S

The Packer style of play is expected to react favorably to the rule changes adopted for this season by the National Professional Football League.

The forward pass is legal from any point behind the line of scrimmage, and the goal post has been moved up to the goal line. Both changes were made to increase the number of thrills in the game and to eliminate the present percentage of tie contests.

The collegiate "ten-yard rule," making

permissible to move the ball in ten yards whenever it is in play within ten yards of the sidelines, also has been approved. The 25-yard penalty for clipping has been retained. The clipping rule has been enforced rigidly in professional football, despite the heavy penalty.

The college fumble rule, prohibiting the defensive men from recovering and running with fumbles, has been retained.
