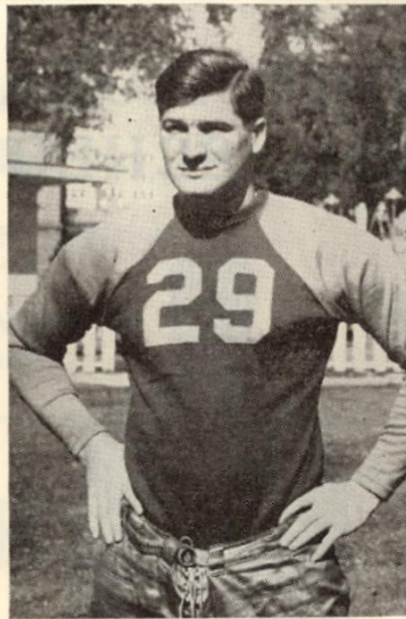




CHESTER JOHNSTON

Fullback

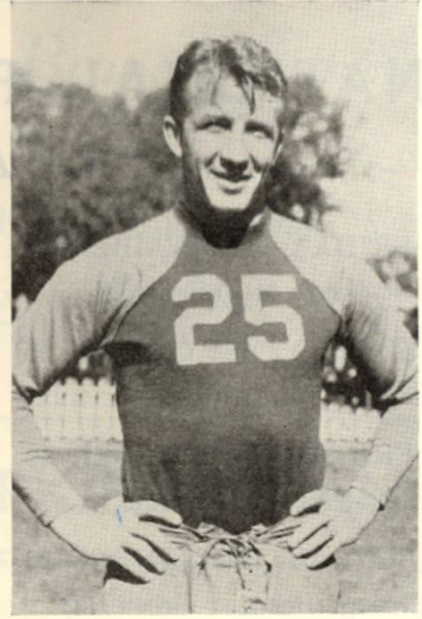

Halfback

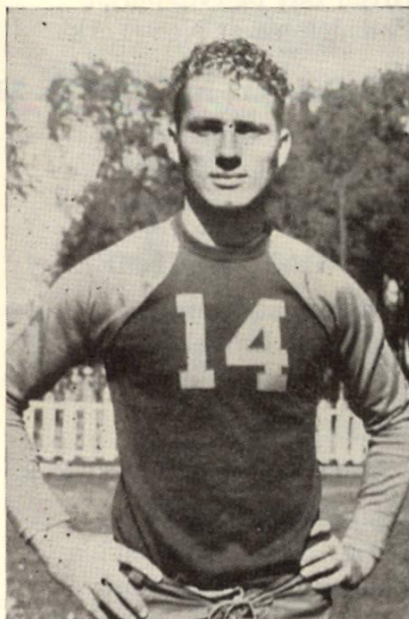

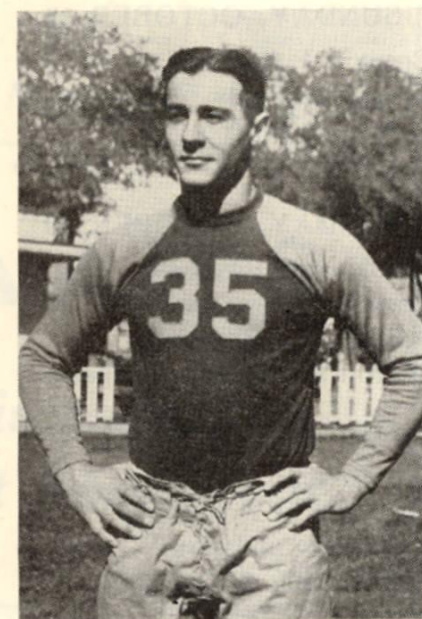

Guard

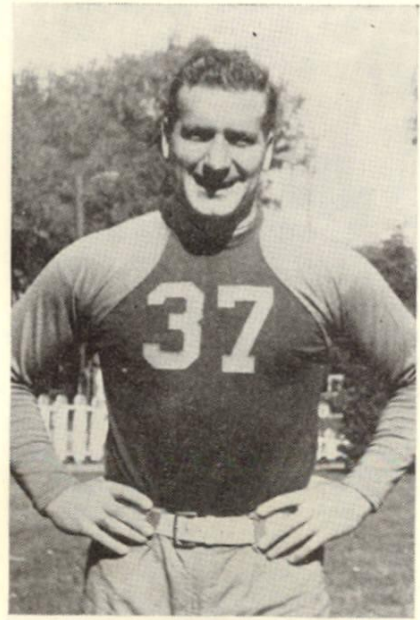

Guard

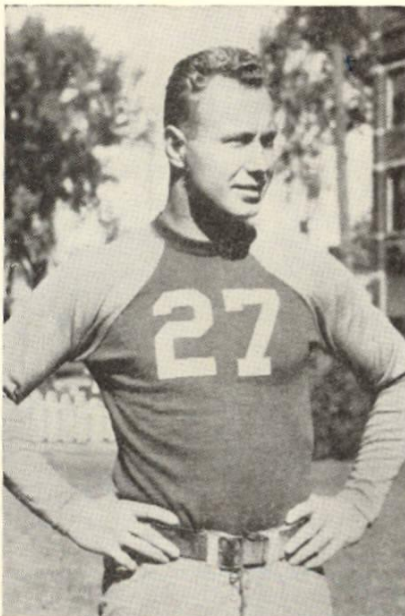

HANK BRUDER

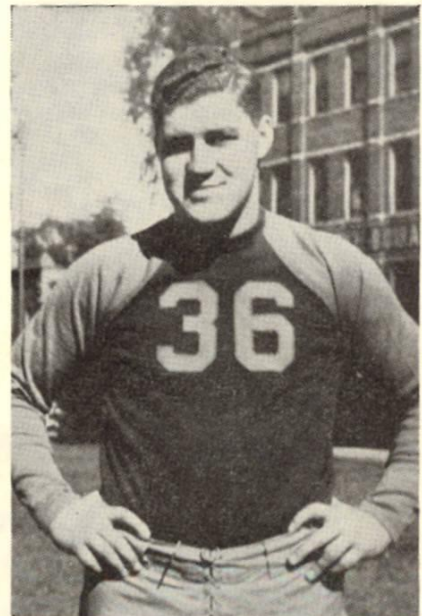
Halfback

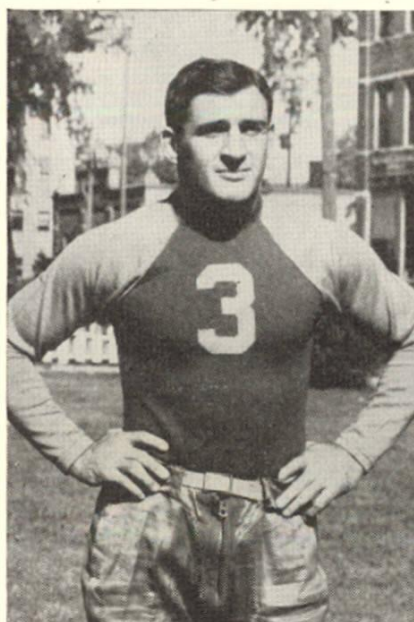

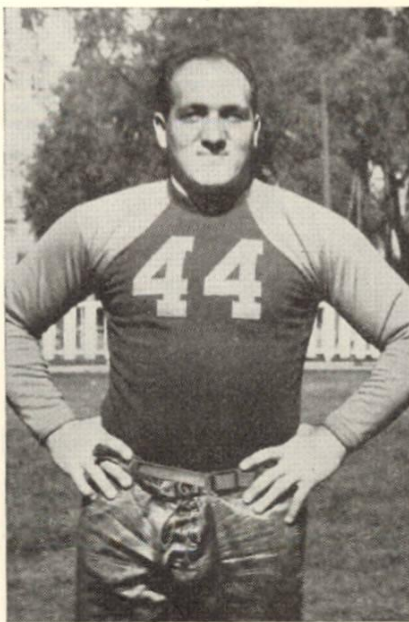

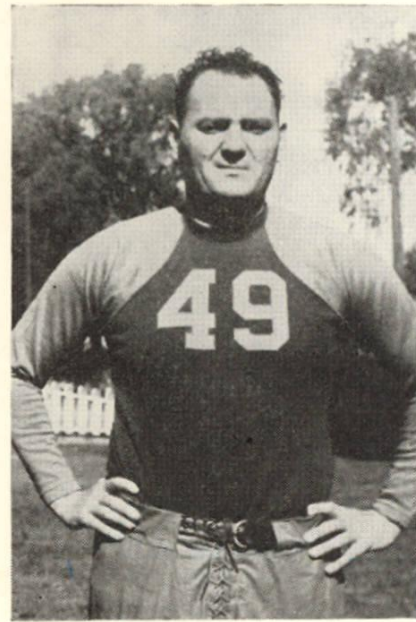
BOB MONNETT

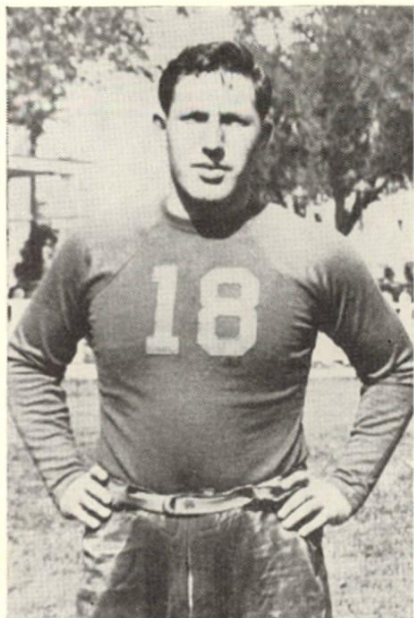
BUCKETS GOLDENBERG

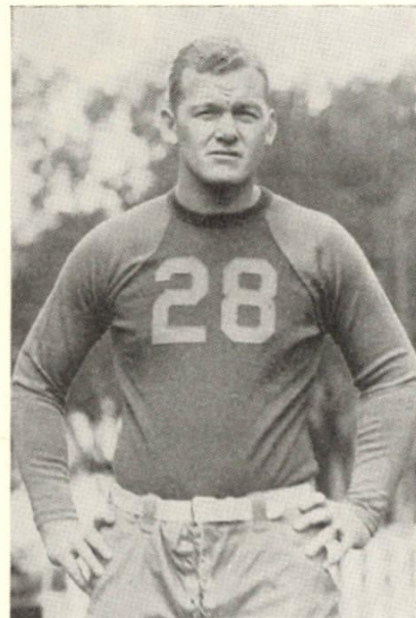


SOL KRAMER

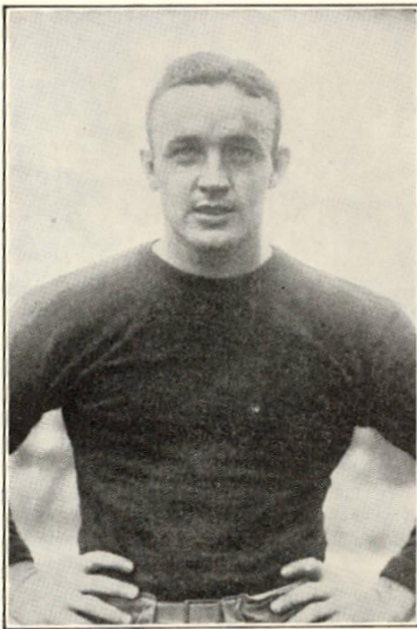

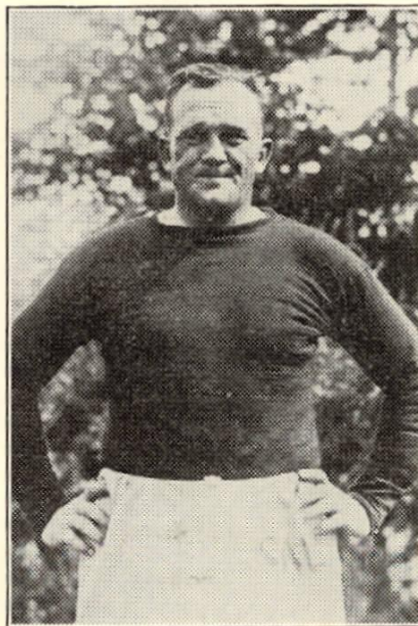

Fullback

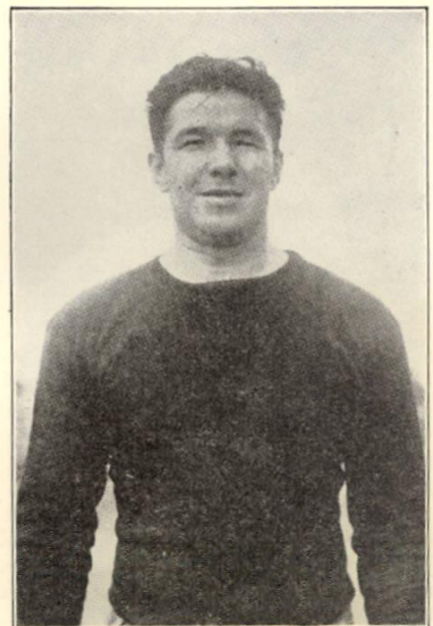

CAL HUBBARD

Tackle

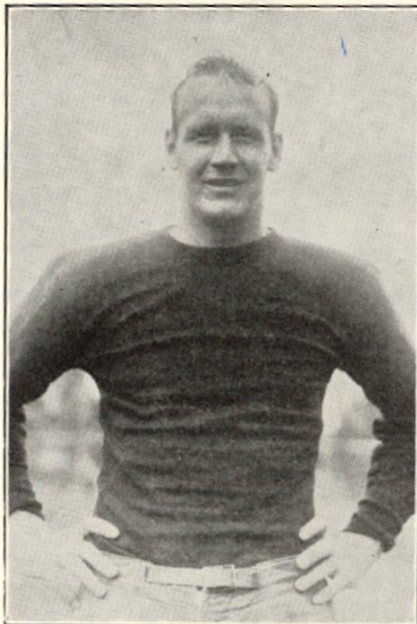
One of the biggest men in pro football . . . weight hits somewhere between 265 and 280 . . . named consistently as all-American pro tackle . . . now playing his ninth year of professional football . . . started with New York Giants in 1927 and 1928 . . . joined the Packers in 1929 and has been here ever since, except for the 1934 season. when he coached at Texas A. & M. . . . starred with Geneva college in the middle 20's . . . married . . . umpires in International Baseball league during the diamond season . . . known as a rulebook authority in both baseball and football.



ARNOLD HERBER

Halfback

Starred at Green Bay West until 1927 . . . made the rounds of a few colleges, including Regis in Colorado and the University of Wisconsin . . . honorary captain Badger frosh one year . . . regarded as best forward passer in pro football . . . called "Flash" along the eastern sector . . . 6 feet 1, 203 pounds . . . tough as nails . . . 25 years old and single . . . lives in Green Bay . . . during his career as a Packer has scored four touchdowns and one extra point for 25 points . . . playing his fifth season with Green Bay.



ALFRED ROSE

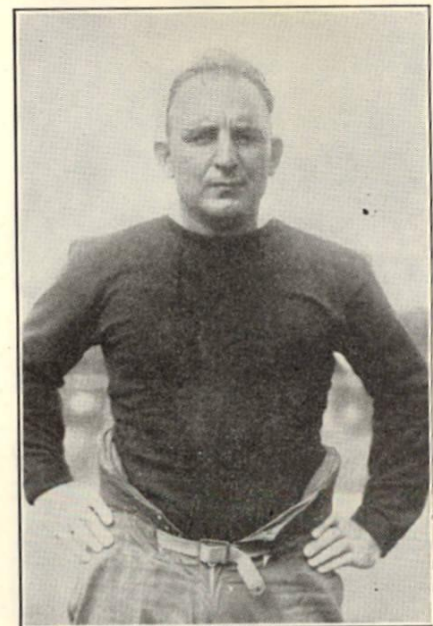
End

Four year Packer veteran . . . previously one season with Providence Steam Rollers . . . long and rangy, expert pass receiver . . . called "Junior" and "Bigum" . . . starred at University of Texas, but now lives in Green Bay . . . married . . . 6 feet-3, 195 pounds . . . salesman . . . has scored five touchdowns in National league competition since joining Packers . . . 30 points.

Year in and year out, an aggressive lineman . . . playing his ninth season of pro ball . . . an Alabama University product . . . has been with Green Bay ever since graduation, except for half of the 1931 season, when he was loaned to Brooklyn . . . unmarried . . . weight 211.

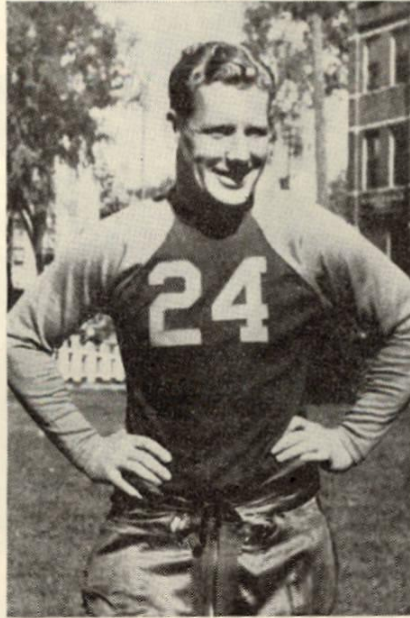




ROGER GROVE

Guard

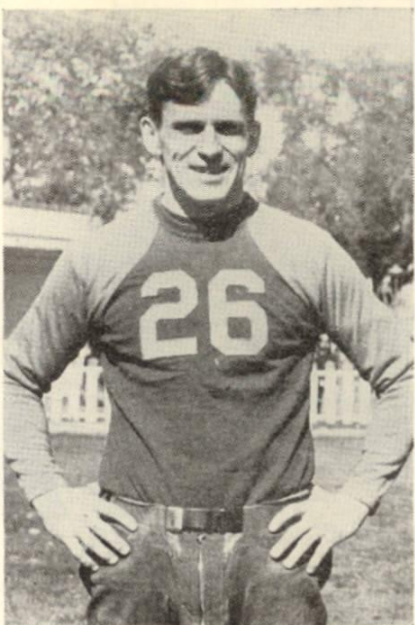

Came to the Packers after a great career at University of Southern California . . . 6 feet tall, 210 pounds . . . 28 years old . . . works during off season at RKO studio . . . home in Los Angeles . . . single . . . real veteran of pro game . . . back last year after one season layoff . . . sixth year with Packers . . . previously had one with Minneapolis, another with Philadelphia.

Halfback

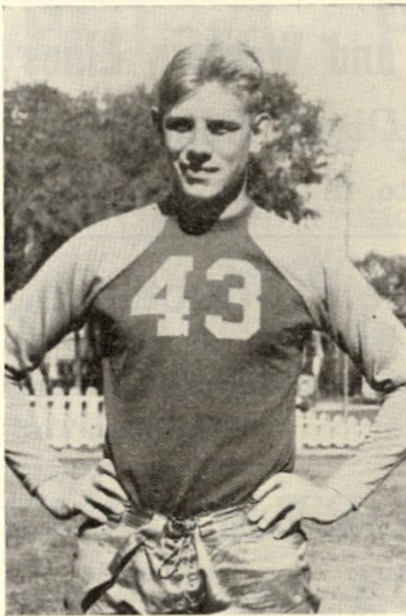

Center

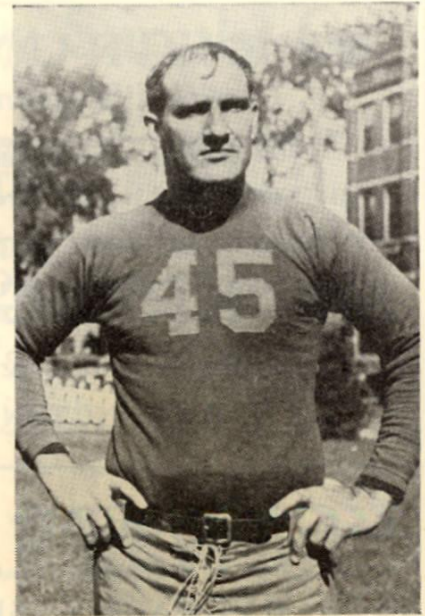

Guard

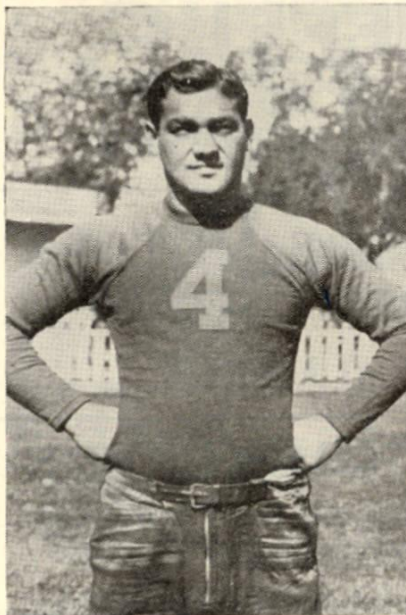

Tackle

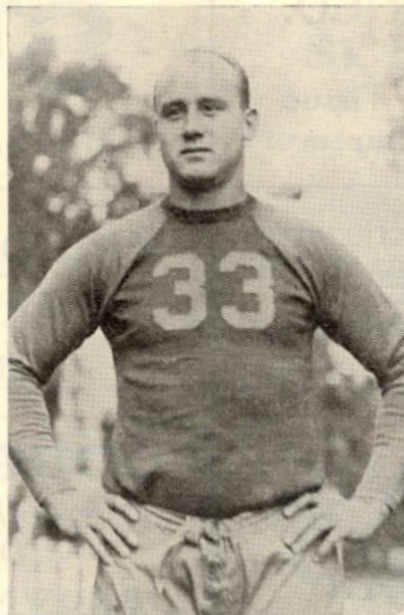

Quarterback

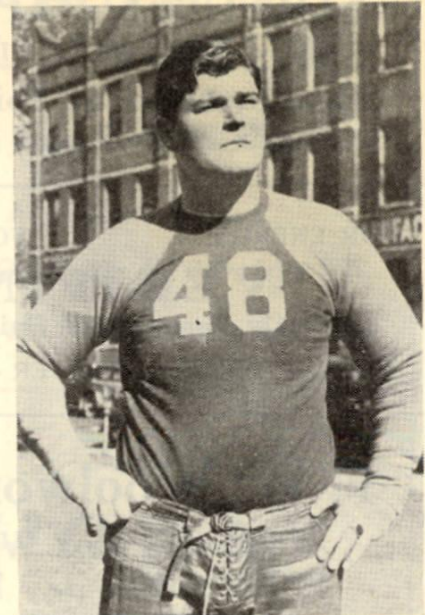
