Wessington-Reds, Combination of Two Old
Local Clubs, Out To Give Real Football

The 1936 Wessington-Reds, heavy professional football eleven representing this section, is a combination of two old football organizations, the Wessington A. C., of Clifton, and the Red Devils, of Passaic.

The Wessingtons organized more than 25 years ago were first prominent in the baseball world, but since 1927 the club has sponsored one the strongest football teams in these parts. To support its fine team, the organization had the Wessington Stadium in Main Avenue, Clifton, built. The team was undefeated, except by National League clubs, from 1927 to 1933.

The Passaic Red Devils were formed in 1929. They enjoyed their best year in 1933, when they won the State Football, Interstate League, and Eastern League championships. In 1934 the team also came through to win the

State title.

For the best interest of the game and in order that the best in football may be given the public in Passaic and Clifton and vicinity, these two clubs merged this season, and the combined team is being backed by Joseph Rosentover, prominent Passaic sportsman, Fred Marchini and Albert Vischia, popular Cliftonites, and Joseph Abbott, of Paterson, a Notre Dame graduate, who in 1932 and 1933 coached and managed the Paterson Night Hawks.

The Wessington-Reds are members of the American Professional Football Association, of which Mr. Rosentover is the president. Others members of this group are: Patersons Panthers, Orange Tornadoes, Stapleton Bears, Bay Parkways, New Rochelle Bulldogs, white Plains, and Mt. Vernon.
