

**ERNIE NEVERS** 

Ernie Nevers is one of the most remarkable athletes in the history of American sport. Glenn Warner, famous coach, names Nevers as the greatest of all football stars, greater than even the Thorpes, Granges, Brickleys and Coys.

Playing for Leland Stanford, Nevers easily won All-American honors for his sensational rushing, kicking and passing. He also won his college letters for the discus, javelin and the running broad jump, although Ernie was never coached in these specialties. Nevers also earned special distinction on his college baseball and basketball teams.

Upon his graduation Nevers remained in the sport spotlight as a pitcher for the St. Louis Browns and as captain of the famous Duluth Eskimos in the National Football League.

The Giants need no introduction to Ernie. This human battering ram crashed

through the Blue and Red team for two touchdowns last season, the only opponent who ever plunged through the Giants' formidable line for two touchdowns in the same game.

Next Sunday Nevers will lead his Duluth Eskimos in action against the Giants, confident of revenging the loss of last season's battle which was decided by only a single point.
