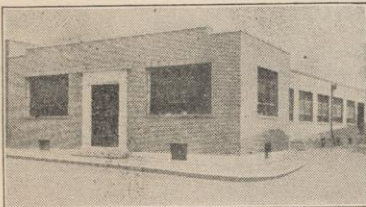

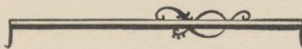

Jackets' Last Minute Aerial Attack Stings Chicago Bears 7-6

STOCKTON'S SUPER-PASSING STARTLES VAST THROG AS HOMAN
AND HAMER SCORE POINTS THAT INFLICT FIRST DEFEAT
ON LEAGUE LEADERS

Frankford beats Chicago — the biggest event in the history of Frankford since the opening of the "L". After suffering four defeats at the hands of the Bears in the past three years, the Yellow Jackets came from behind in the 4th period, at Shibe Park last Saturday, and stung the Bears 7-6, virtually clinching the Championship of the National Professional Football League for the first time.

The whole Yellow Jacket squad, although minus several stars, who are on the crippled list, deserves the highest praise for the wonderful exhibition of football they displayed against the greatest grid machine in the country.

But we must give individual mention to the players of the local eleven, whose individual feats were directly responsible for the victory.

First is Guy Chamberlin, end and coach of the Yellow Jackets, who has given Frankford the greatest team in its history. All Guy did in that hectic struggle was to block Driscoll's try for a field goal, and also his try for extra point after Senn had scored

the touchdown besides playing the greatest defensive game of his career.

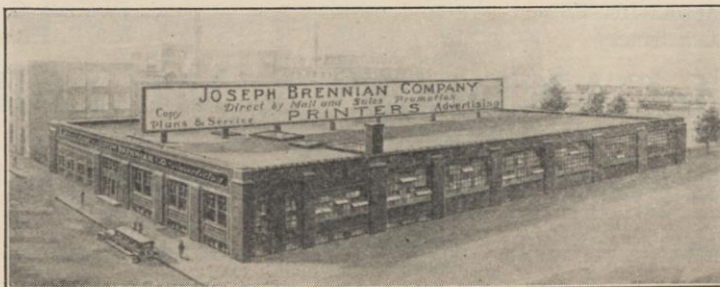
Second, Tex Hamer, who scored the winning point after Homan's touchdown, that won the game. It was the super-football totting and punting of Tex in the first half that kept the Bears with their backs to the wall. His defensive playing in the last half was better than the best. It sure was Tex's day!

Third, "Two-Bits" Homan, Frankford's midget quarterback, who caught the pass and crossed the goal line tying the score for Frankford. As the Jackets' field general he displayed wonderful headwork in calling the plays, especially during the last minute rally that brought victory to Frankford.

Fourth Houston Stockton, our sterling fullback and super-passer of the National League. He twirled the pass, a toss of 38 yards, to Homan for a touchdown. Only several minutes before he had heaved the pigskin 40 yards to Crowthers, both times warding off several tacklers who threatened to throw him for a loss.

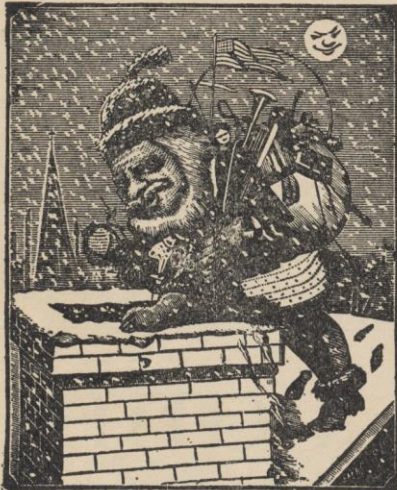

JACKETS' LAST MINUTE AERIAL ATTACK STINGS BEARS

Last, but not least, Rae Crowthers, who was the receipt of Stockton's first heave which netted a gain of over 40 yards. Rae's defensive playing at the wing position will long be remembered by all who were lucky enough to witness this great struggle.

A synopsis of the Championship battle that will go down as the greatest of all grid games in the history of Frankford is as follows:—

Frankford received the kick-off and directly afterward punted the ball touching a Chicago player and Weir recovered the ball for Frankford on the Bears 25-yard line. Tex made 7 yards around right end, but a penalty of 15 yards was inflicted on the Jackets. Following this a misplay caused the Jackets to lose 20 more yards. Frankford punted and from the non the two teams see sawed back and forth, Frankford out playing the Bears, keeping the game in Chicago territory.

The third peirod went scoreless and half the last quarter had passed and it looked like the fray would end in a scoreless tie

when Senn, a Bear substitute, found a whole at tackle and behind beautiful interference, dashed 62 yards to the goal line. Chamberlin blocked Driscoll's try for the extra point. With five minutes to play Frankford received the kickoff and the famous march began. A short pass, Stockton to Crowthers, gained 5 yards. Another pass between the same two. A long cross across the field took the pigskin to Chicago's 30 yard line. Here Tex made a 50-yard gain when he reversed his field. But in the fourth down, 3 yards still were to be gained. Again "Two-Bits" called on the mighty Stockton and the latter, warding off several tacklers after running back ten yards, twirled another pass to Homan who had entered the end zone of the Bears at full speed. "Two-Bits" gathered the oval to his midget form and the score was tie.

And Tex, just to make it a perfect point placement, kicked the extra point and the Bears were defeated for the first time this season and incidentally the first time at the hands of the Jackets, since these two rivals have met on the gridiron.
