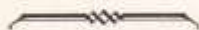

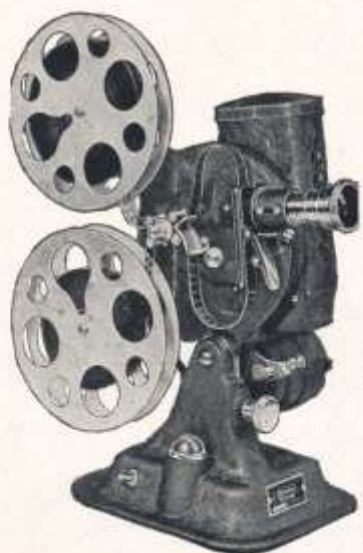

JOHN BIANCONE  
*Halfback—Oregon State*

Selected as Pacific Coast Conference halfback in 1933, Johnny Biancone again covered himself with glory for Oregon State in 1934, then upon graduation in 1935 with A. B. Degree, signed for backfield duty with the Brooklyn Dodgers of the National League. He was born in Portland, Oregon, 1912, and is 5 feet 7 inches tall, weighing 165 lbs. Biancone is of Italian decent, has brown eyes and chestnut brown hair. He saw action as a backfield player for the Lincoln High School of Portland then enrolled, upon graduation, at Oregon State, where he was tutored during 1931-'32-'33-'34 by Paul Schissler, present coach of the Brooklyn Dodgers. Coach Schissler considers Biancone as one of the outstanding backs ever to come out of Oregon State. At present Johnny is a first lieutenant in the Reserve Corps and is also a mail clerk in Portland when not playing football. Played with Brooklyn Dodgers under his college coach, Paul Schissler in 1935 and part of 1936. First year with Panthers. Dazzles the fans with his spectacular broken field runs.
